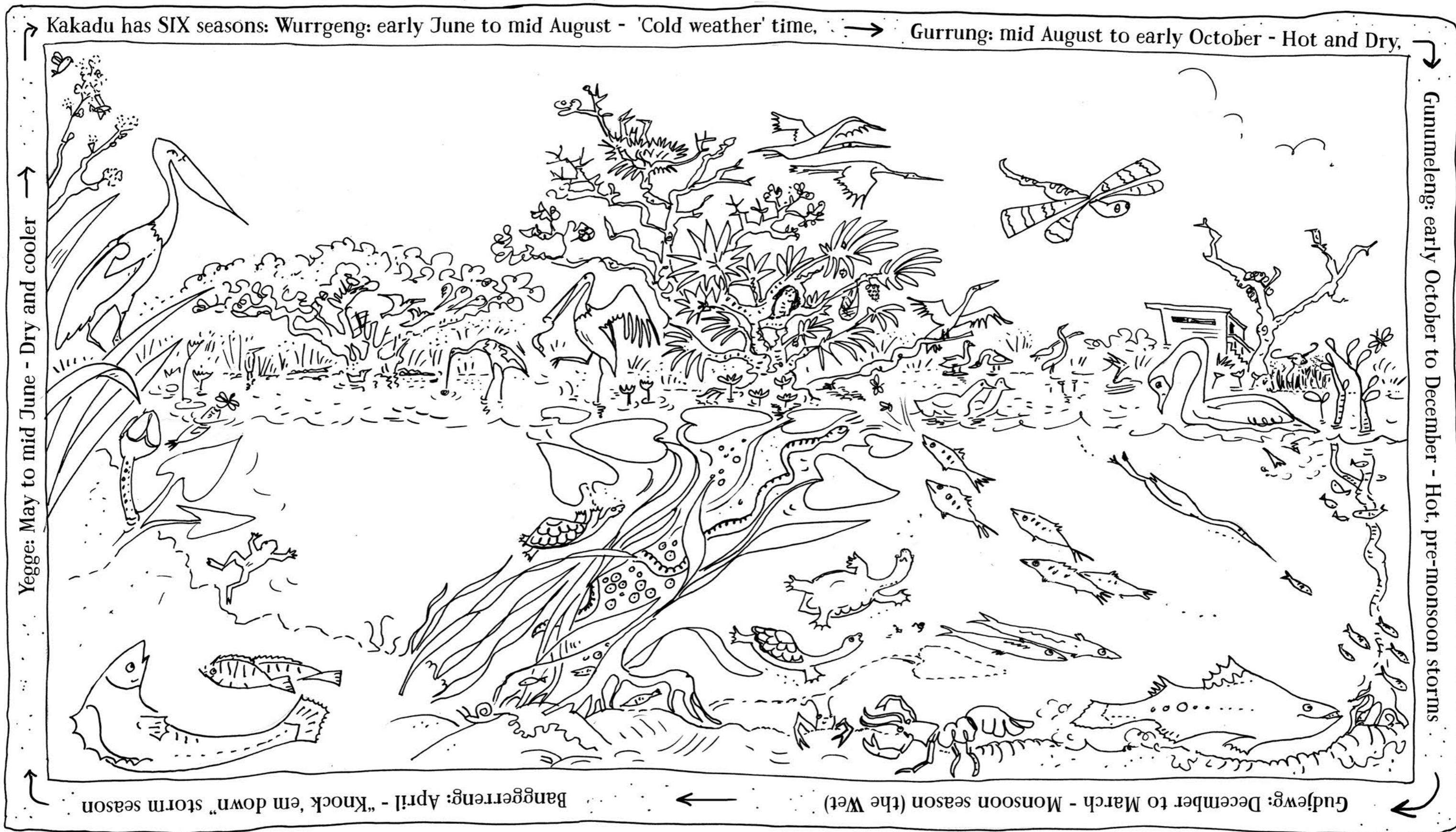


Dry to Dry - Colour in sheet



Kakadu has SIX seasons: Wurrng: early June to mid August - 'Cold weather' time, → Gurrung: mid August to early October - Hot and Dry,

Yegge: May to mid June - Dry and cooler →

Gunumeleng: early October to December - Hot, pre-monsoon storms

← Banggerreng: April - "Knock 'em down" storm season  
 ← Gudjwag: December to March - Monsoon season (the Wet)
